

EnoLogic NetFilter Home installation guide

1. Installation

- Start the EnoLogic NetFilter Home "Setup.exe" file which you have acquired either on CDROM or from EnoLogic's webpage. The CDROM version starts automatically, if Windows is configured to auto startup, when you insert the CD.
- During the installation EnoLogic NetFilter itself under

`\Program Files\EnoLogic\NetFilter\`

on an English/US Windows version.

- After the installation is completed EnoLogic NetFilter is installed as a service and will be started automatically next time the machine is rebooted. You will be offered the choice between restarting the machine immediately or waiting. You must restart the machine before proceeding to the next section.

2. Configuration of EnoLogic NetFilter

- The settings for EnoLogic NetFilter can be configured with the program EnoLogic NetFilter Admin, which is described in section 3 in the user's guide. The administration program requires you to input a username and password before you can modify the settings.

- The standard administrator username and password is "admin". You should modify the standard login the first time you use the administration program.

3. Configuration of browsers

- During the installation, Microsoft Internet Explorer, Mozilla, Netscape 6, and Opera are configured automatically for filtering.
- Other browsers can be configured manually for filtering by EnoLogic NetFilter. This is described further in section 2.3 in the user's guide.

- More information about installation and use of EnoLogic NetFilter can be found in the user's guide, which can be opened from the Start menu by choosing:

Start → Programs → EnoLogic → NetFilter Home → NetFilter Manual

after the software has been installed on the computer.
